Create singular and plural imperative forms of the Latin verbs given in the first column. Follow the first example:

Latin Verb	Latin Imperative singular (Addressing ONE person)	Latin Imperative plural (Addressing TWO OR MORE persons)
dormire (=to sleep)	<u>DORMI</u> (sleep!)	<u>DORMITE</u> (sleep!)
spectare (=to watch)	<u>specta</u> (watch!)	<u>spectate</u> (watch!)
laborare (= to work)	<u>labora</u> (work!)	<u>laborate</u> (work!)
ridere (=to smile)	<u>ride</u> (smile!)	<u>RIDETE</u> (smile!)
audire (=to listen)	<u>audi</u> (listen!)	<u>audite</u> (listen!)
sedere (=to sit)	<u>sede</u> (sit!)	<u>SEDETE</u> (sit!)
scribere (= to write)	<u>scribe</u> (write!)	<u>SCRIBITE</u> (write!)
surgere (=to stand up)	<u>surge</u> (stand up!)	<u>SURGITE</u> (stand up!)
verre (=to sweep)	<u>verre</u> (sweep!)	<u>VERRITE</u> (sweep!)
legere (= to read)	<u>lega</u> (read!)	<u>legate</u> (read!)
tangere (= to touch)	<u>tange</u> (touch!)	<u>TANGITE</u> (touch!)
intrare (=to enter)	<u>intra</u> (enter!)	<u>intrate</u> (enter!)
coquere (=to cook)	<u>coque</u> (cook!)	<u>COQUITE</u> (cook!)
